




# Why Friendship Peak Beyond the trek?



# **Short Itinerary**

- Day 1 Arrive at Manali in the morning. Breakfast at the hotel followed by a short hike and introduction to the climbing workshop.
- Day 2 1hr drive to Dhundi followed by Trek to BAKKARTHATCH 3km 3,300M.
- Day 3 Bakkarthatch to Lady trek 4km (3,840 m) equipment class and distribution followed by gear fitting.
- Day 4 Load ferry and acclimatisation walk to summit camp 2km.
- Day 5 Rest day.
- Day 6 Trek to summit camp 1km and get some rest as it the D day summit push night.
- Day 7 Duffer day.
- Day 8 Trek to Dhundi 5km and Drive back to Manali.






## Friendship Peak

Friendship peak is a mountain of **5,289** meters elevation situated in the Kullu district of Himachal Pradesh. Being one of the popular trekking peaks of the Pir Panjal range, the hike starts from Solang Valley near Manali. Friendship peak is considered from moderate to hard grade and is a good option for experienced trekkers wanting to switch to mountaineering.

The peak is surrounded by verdant meadows and dense forests with thick snow layers on the summit. The summit opens up stunning views of Indrasen, Deo Tibba, Hanuman Tibba, Shitidhar and the distant Dhauladhar range. You can consider this as a trekking + mountaineering expedition of 8 days.

Unlike any other high pass or lake treks, Friendship Peak reveals a peak climbing experience at just 5,000 meters. The climb is moderate at first and strenuous towards the summit. Therefore, if you are looking for something **challenging** than hikes but within your reach, Friendship Peak is a perfect choice. Along with the good training, the trek is a treat with mind blowing Himachal beauty.

The trek begins from Manali then a drive to Dhundi and the real hike commences here. From Day 4 itself, you will start load-ferry for Camp 1 at 4,800 meters elevation. If the weather is optimal on the 6th day you will stand on the head of the Friendship peak. Within a week you will achieve your dream and head towards home.

## · when is the best time to go to for this expedition?

friendship peak expedition is best attempted during the months of may, june, august, september, and october, as the harshness of winter is left behind, and trials clear up considerably, this expedition avoided in july due to the occurrence of landslides.

## is it a beginner friendly trek? how difficult is this expedition?

no. it is considered to be a difficult expedition with a difficulty level of 6/8. the level of this expedition is difficult, which demands physical fitness, stamina, and endurance. prior trekking experience of scaling a high mountain peak is required which means beginners are not welcomed. the duration of the expedition is 6 days and it is around 35 kilometres altogether. you would find some steep slopes or risky ridges. there are tricky glacier sections that need to be crossed in addition to steep climbs. irrespective of your prior experience, it is essential that you be very fit and well prepared for the expedition.

## how much fitness is required for this expedition?

good stamina is a must for this expedition. if you are a beginner, we would suggest increasing your stamina by walking at least 7 to 10 kilometers daily for 1 month prior to the start of the expedition.

## what will the temperature like on this expedition?

the temperature ranges from 10 to 15 degrees during the daytime and dips to about -6 to 4 during nights.



## **FAQ**

 what are the interesting places to visit if i have time before or after the expedition?

prior to the expedition, you can spend a day acclimatizing in manali if you are somewhere from the plans. you can go for local sightseeing and enjoy himachal cuisine. if you want to go sightseeing in manali, you can gear up for it after the expedition. the interesting places in and around manali include hadimba temple, vashisht temple, mall road and many more. you can also enjoy rafting in kullu. all these places are amazing and if you have an extra day after the expedition, we suggest you go out and explore the beauty of kullu and manali. the scenic beauty and impeccable natural landscapes are something to look out for.

will we have bathing facilities on the trek?

you will be able to take a bath during your base camp stay on day 1. while on the trek, campsites will not have a bathing facility.

- who will be our emergency contact in case our families need to reach us?
   your families, in case of an emergency, will be able to reach our team at the base camp. the emergency contact number will be provided to you a week prior to your trek date.
- what will the evacuation process be like, in case of an emergency?

in case of any emergency, if the trekker is in a stable health condition to trek back to base camp, he will be accompanied by one of our team members back to the base camp. in case of a health issue preventing a trek back, an evacuation team will be able to get you back to the base camp. however, the evacuation expenses are not to be borne by folka adventures.

## Folka Holidays Booking Policy

- Your Hotel has laid down some rules, and it's our job to let you know what they are.
- The primary guest must be at least 18 years old to be able to check into this Hotel.
